Born 1992, Vitória, Brazil

Kika Carvalho is a Capixaba visual artist, being the first prominent woman to paint walls in the city of Vitória, in the state of Espírito Santo, Brazil, with her works exhibited at the Pinacoteca and in galleries in Portugal, Italy, the United States, and soon in Spain with Reiners Gallery. In 2021, she was nominated for the PIPA Award, and in 2022, some of her works were exhibited in the program 'Encontro com Fátima Bernardes' on TV Globo as the 'Artist of the Week.' Her works focus on the portrait of black women, culture, and African matrix, with blue as the predominant color since 2017.
